

EDUCATION FUND ACBS MALAYSIA CHAPTER

Objective:

To sponsor or partially sponsor practitioners who want to attend CBS-related trainings.

Cap on sponsorship:

Maximum RM500 per person per year. The amount of sponsorship per event can be partial or full depending on the type of training and also funds available within the education fund.

Guidelines

The training can be from local or international trainers.

Deadline to send in request for sponsorship: at least 2 weeks before the training commences.

If an announcement is made, all applicants within the stipulated duration will be reviewed. If no such duration stated, applicants shall be reviewed based on first come first serve basis.

Criteria for considerations:

1. Is it a relevant and valid CBS-related workshop
2. Does the applicant demonstrate a genuine interest in the area? Considerations includes, but not limited to:
 - a) Type of work
 - b) Past or current efforts related to CBS
3. Does the applicant's context demonstrate the need for sponsorship? Considerations includes, but not limited to:
 - a) Student, unemployment vs employed status
 - b) Type of employment
 - c) Financial background (if possible)
4. How does the applicant plan to utilise the training received?
5. Has the applicant received sponsorship up to the cap for the year?
6. For returning recipients, did they fulfill their prior agreement to contribute back? Has their qualifying criteria changed?

The offer for sponsorship would also be subjected to:

- a) The applicant agreeing to contribute to the CBS community by the following methods:

1. To provide a written report (max 1000 words) or short video (max 5 min) regarding their learning experience of the workshop within 2 weeks of training completion. This is meant to be a reflective and sharing report about the learning experience, not the workshop's activities. The report will be publish in the chapter's communication platform.

And

2. A meaningful contribution back to the CBS community within 3 months of training completion, for example: attending a live social media event, writing an educational article, demonstrating learnt skills in their career, etc. The type of contribution can be in any form but subject to the agreement of the ACBS MYS committee. This contribution need not be time or resource consuming.

b) The applicant being successful in registering for the CBS-related training that they are applying for.

This guideline is subjected to 6-monthly review and can be changed accordingly during the review. An announcement will be made in official communication platform if such changes occur.
